



HIPAA Compliance Requirements

The Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) contains requirements that must be met by healthcare providers to keep all types of protected health information (PHI) secure. **Each rule within HIPAA sets a standard for assessing and recording security measures to protect patient data.**

What security measures are required by the HIPAA Rules?

By complying with these four key HIPAA requirements for healthcare organizations, you can reduce your risk of a data breach, avoid large fines and reputational damage, and protect your patients from identity theft:



1 Conduct a thorough Security Risk Analysis

Perform a **complete assessment of the security protections your organization currently has in place, as well as any areas where sensitive information is not being well protected.** All findings must be documented, and the results should be revisited often so that necessary changes can be made.

2 Create and update customized policies and procedures

Your organization must have **documented policies for the administrative, physical, and technical safeguards** you have in place. These policies should be stored online, accessible from anywhere.

3 Ensure Business Associate Agreements are in place

Your organization must **maintain effective Business Associate Agreements with all vendors that will have access to PHI**, and update these BAAs regularly to increase protection.

4 Train Employees

Employees must be **trained regularly** on what is expected of them regarding proper handling of PHI.
